RACING INCIDENTS

(Race No.23-28)

Going : Good
Penetrometer reading : 3.3 cms.
Railings' Position : Railings are positioned at 1600 Metres from the Winning Post with an average width of 7 Metres.

1st Race: 23. The Nagarjunasagar Plate (About) 1100 Metres. Maiden Indian Horses 2 years old only.(Terms). (7 Runners):

NEXT LEVEL (P.Kiran Rai) jumped awkwardly outwards at the start.

STIGMATA (Shiva Kumar) brushed railings approaching 1000 Metres.

Jockey Shiva Kumar, the rider of STIGMATA reported that his mount was hanging 'in' throughout the Race. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Bobby M was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Routine sample was taken for analysis from the winner, b g KINGOFTHEJUNGLE

2nd Race: 24. The Pattadakal Plate (About) 1400 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45, 5 years old and over.(12 Runners):

KAZURI (M Rajesh Kumar) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. Vikram Appachu was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improves to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day, on the Race Track.

Jockey M Rajesh Kumar, the rider of KAZURI was reprimanded for travelling wide rounding the final bend for no apparent reason.

Jockey Nikhil Naidu, the rider of TOUGH SUSSEX, reported that he accidentally lost his whip passing 300 Metres.

Jockey Chethan Gowda, the rider of COUNTRY'S POWER was fined **Rs.1,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to SUFFICIENT PROOF (Dashrath Singh) on his inside passing 200 Metres.

Jockey M Madhu Babu, the rider of MOMOTARO reported that his mount did not raise a dfluent gallop, soon after jumping out of the Starting Gastyes and thereafter ran detached from the field. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. Trainer Mr.Rakesh was informed to ensure better performance of his charge in future.

Routine sample was taken for analysis from the winner, b g COUNTRY'S POWER

3rd Race: 25. The Fame And Glory Plate (About) 1100 Metres. Horses rated 20 to 45. (12 Runners):

EXPORT QUALITY (N.Tauseef Ahmed) planted and lost many lengths at the start. In view of its behaviour Trainer Mr. Srinivas Babu G was informed that he must not accept with it again until its behaviour improves to the satisfaction of the Stipendiary Stewards in **One Mock Race** on a Race Day, on the Race Track.

ELOIKA (Chethan Gowda) jumped awkwardly inwards and inconvenienced BRAVE ADMIRAL (M.Rajesh Kumar) on its inside, at the start.

COUNTRY'S FAME (Arshad Alam) jumped awkwardly outwards and and inconvenienced BRAVE ADMIRAL (M.Rajesh Kumar) on its outside, at the start.

Jockey H Rahul, the rider of OCTOPUSSY was fined **Rs.1,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to MY QUEEN (K.Sai Kiran) on his inside, which went onto SAFE BET (R.Anand), on its inside, before passing the red marker post.

Jockey Shamaz Shareef, the rider of ROYAL DESIGN reported that his mount was hanging 'out' rounding the final bend. The horse was impounded for veterinary examination but no abnormality was reported. However, Trainer Mr. Dinesh Pujar was informed to take appropriate corrective measures before accepting with it again.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from the winner, b f COUNTRY'S FAME.

4th Race: 26. The Meena & S.Rajashekar Memorial Trophy - Div I (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 60 and above. (9 Runners):

It was reported after the Race that MINT (Dashrath Singh), pulled up lame on right hind. Trainer Mr. Bobby M was informed that he must produce a **Fitness Certificate** from the Club's Veterinary Officer before accepting with it again.

5th Race: 27. The Sahyadri Plate (About) 1600 Metres. Horses rated 40 to 65. (10 Runners):

Jockey R Shiva Kumar, the rider of GREEK GODDESS, was severely cautioned in the presence of his Master Trainer Mr. Tejaswi P C, for not being alert at the start and for losing his both stirrups soon after the jump out and completed the race without regaining the stirrups. He was cautioned that he would be dealt with appropriately, if he repeats the same mistake, again.

Jockey R Shiva Kumar, the rider of GREEK GODDESS, was fined **Rs.1,000/-** for shifting 'in' and causing interference to DEIMUS (Shiva Kumar), on his inside, before passing the red marker post and again for shifting 'in' and causing interference to BE BOLD (Chotu Jaiswar), on his inside, approaching 1200 Metres.

Jockey Shiva Kumar, the rider of DEIMUS, was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing SAN VINTO (Arshad Alam), on his inside, approaching 1000 Metres.

Jockey Mohammed Mushraf, the rider of MARCH TO VICTORY was was reprimanded for shifting 'in' and inconveniencing ASCENDENCY (V.R.Jagdeesh), on his inside passing 300 Metres.

GREEK GODDESS (R.Shiva Kumar) sustained clipped injury on right hind cannon.

Surprise sample was taken for analysis from the winner, b g TOP STRIKER.

6th Race: 28. The Meena & S.Rajashekar Memorial Trophy - Div II (About) 1200 Metres. Horses rated 60 and above. (9 Runners):

Jockey Mukesh Kumar, the rider of MAKINO was fined **Rs.3,000/-** for his negligence pertaining to "Weighing in", in that, he failed to "Weigh In" after the Race.

Routine sample was taken for analysis from the winner, ch g TURF LEGEND.

Ltd., Rules of Racing, on his mount COLONEL HARTY, in the above race, until his appeal is heard and **finally disposed off, by the Board.**
